Encyclopedia with Semantic Computing (ESC)

Production

The ESC is designed to be published in multiple formats:

Professional Edition, Paper Form – To be published by World Scientific Publishing Company (WSPC) in both paper form and PDF form (for online access). The articles in paper form are compiled into a book for distribution, and the PDF form of each article is available for separate online access.

The first author of an article is entitled for 12% royalty of each online access of the article and all first authors together are entitled to receive 12% of royalty for each sale or subscription of ESC as a whole. The corresponding area editor is entitled for 3% royalty of each online access of the article, and all area editors together are entitled to receive 3% of royalty for each sale or subscription of ESC as a whole.

The length of each article should be no more than 10 pages (<u>sample</u>, <u>guidelines</u>). Suggested structure: (1) Abstract and Keywords, (2) Problem Description, (3) Method (or a typical solution), (4) Performance, (5) Other Solutions, (6) Additional Comments, (7) Acknowledgments, and (8) References.

Layman Edition, Short (< 1 minute; <u>sample</u>) – To be published by <u>Knowledge Societies</u> Press (KS Press) in video form, and is free to the public. They are produced if no suitable ones can be found from the Internet. Each video describes a problem and briefly a solution. Author(s) are acknowledged, and references to other editions and online resources with a similar length, if available (example), are provided.

Layman Edition, Concise (1-3 minutes; sample), Medium (3-5 minutes), and Long (> 5 minutes) – To be published by Knowledge Societies Press (KS Press) in video form, with a moderate fee when appropriate. They are produced if no suitable ones can be found from the Internet. Each video describes a problem and a solution in more details. References to other editions are provided. If applicable, the first author of an article is entitled for 36% royalty of each online access of the article. The corresponding area editor is entitled for 9% royalty of each online access of the article. Author(s) are acknowledged, and references to other online resources (if available) (example) are provided.

Below is the ESC workflow:

1. Authors submit articles to the area editor who will review and make sure of the technical quality. Revisions may be needed upon area editors' requests.

- 2. Area editors submit reviewed articles to the Editor-in-Chief. Author(s) are invited to provide Power Point documents (for the layman editions) together with a script for each slide.
- 3. The Editor-in-Chief submits the reviewed articles (professional edition) to WSPC who will work with the authors to produce the professional edition.
- 4. The Editor-in-Chief submits the invited Power Point documents to KS Online who will work with the authors to produce videos in order to meet the timing and quality requirements. If appropriate an article may be decomposed into multiple videos for a finer granularity.
